“Free Orchestra Concert Features Saxophone Concerto”

The Civic Orchestra of Tucson (COT) continues its 41st season with a free concert titled “Contrasts: Music of Russian Composers.” The concert will take place on Saturday, March 11, at 7:00 pm in Crowder Hall at the UA Fred Fox School of Music, 1017 N Olive Rd. in Tucson.

The works were chosen by long-time COT Music Director Herschel Kreloff to show a wide variety of classical music by Russian composers. On the program is Tchaikovsky’s well-known Symphony No. 6, *Pathétique*, which includes many themes that listeners will recognize. A less familiar work is *Concerto for Alto Saxophone and Strings* by Alexander Glazunov, with soloist Zack Brennan, a talented local musician. Also on the program is Sergei Prokofiev’s *Overture on Jewish Themes*, filled with rhythmic melodies that feature the clarinet, giving the piece an almost Klezmer feel.

No tickets are required for the concert, and a reception will follow, giving audience members an opportunity to chat with the Music Director, soloist, and orchestra musicians.
