Civic Orchestra of Tucson – Silent Auction Rules and Guidelines

By bidding in the Civic Orchestra of Tucson’s Silent Auction, each bidder agrees to these auction rules.

1. Bidding will commence at 2:00 pm and continue until the start of the concert is announced, at approximately 2:30 pm. Bidding will restart at the beginning of the intermission and conclude at the end of the intermission.
2. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds unless otherwise noted. All items are “as is.” Civic Orchestra of Tucson (COT) has attempted to describe items correctly, but neither warrants nor represents and in no event shall be responsible for the correctness of descriptions, genuineness, authorship, provenance, or condition of the items. No statement made during this auction, on the COT website, or made orally at the auction or elsewhere, shall be deemed such a warranty, representation, or assumption of liability.
3. The auction item value listed is an estimate of fair market value. Items have not been appraised unless so noted. The amount you pay above this fair market value estimate is normally tax deductible as a charitable contribution. Please consult your tax adviser to clarify amount of deduction.
4. Bidders must review any restrictions or limitations listed on the Bid Sheet and related information for each item. Note that restaurant certificates generally do not include alcohol, tax, or gratuities, unless specified. Tips at restaurants should be based on the full value of the meal.
5. People under the age of 21 cannot bid on items in the ‘Food’ category that include alcohol.
6. Payment for items won by a winning bid must be made in full this evening to the cashier in the following fashion:
 - a. For items purchased for the “Buy It Now” price, take your Bid Sheet to the Cashier at any time during the auction.
 - b. Auction winners will be announced near the close of the concert and given a “Winner’s Sheet” with total amount due.
 - c. Take your Winner’s Sheet to the Cashier. Accepted payment methods are cash, credit card, or check made payable to Civic Orchestra of Tucson.
 - d. Winners will receive an envelope containing the item(s) won (i.e., tickets, gift certificates, etc.) or, for larger items, a Claim Ticket. Take your Claim Ticket to the auction area, where a volunteer will exchange it for the item.
7. Winners must pick up all items by the end of the event, unless special arrangements are made.
8. Civic Orchestra of Tucson reserves the right to add or withdraw items, without notice, to or from the auction.
9. Each person bidding assumes all risks and hazards related to the auction and items obtained at the auction.
